The Lighthouse Charity Legacy Policy

At The Lighthouse Charity, we welcome all gifts in wills, however large or small. Our Legacy Policy is to use gifts to help make a difference by funding significant development projects, whether buildings, equipment or staff.

The Lighthouse Charity also welcomes gifts in memoriam as a wonderful and appropriate way to remember a loved one.

We encourage gifts to be for general purposes rather than restricted ones since needs change over the years. We will try to direct any gifts to the donator's known areas of interest in the church (e.g. music, buildings, children and youth, mission or aid) and the Church's priorities at the time.

We will acknowledge gifts in a way the trustees feel most appropriate, bearing in mind the wishes of the donor and the executors. Equally, we will ensure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.

If a donor wishes to talk to someone confidently about the purposes of their gift, what it might fund, and how/if it is to be acknowledged, then the trustees will make such a person available.
